QUASH YOUR BENCH WARRANT NOW

What is a Bench Warrant?

A bench warrant is issued by a judge when a defendant violates the rules of the court. Most often, the defendant has simply failed to show up for a scheduled court appearance. Once a bench warrant is issued, the police can treat it like any other arrest warrant - and use it to bring the accused back in front of the judge.

Due to Court closures until April 24, 2020 (at a minimum), the courts are allowing phone calls to quash warrants. You do not need to appear for court, simply contact the court that issued the warrant, and request for it to be quashed. The court will set you on their calendar for some time after they reopen on April 24, 2020.
